Dear Pitsburg Church of the Brethren, Merry Christmas! We are grateful to God for the MANY ways this group partners with us in prayer, finances, and encouragement. Below is a "report in pictures" of how we're seeing God move.



We are happy to report that all of our Bible translation students passed their first semester of classes and are preparing to continue! Over the holidays, each student has a one-month break to relax or return to their home country. Several plan to visit their families in Myanmar, where civil war is still causing strife.

Pray for their safety as they travel, particularly the young men who are at risk of being captured and forced to join the fighting.



Sometimes we think of life in categories like "ministry opportunities" or "fun." But God doesn't waste ANY category. Ivy met Net earlier this year at a birthday party. Net recently decided to follow Christ and is soaking in all the Bible studies and teaching she can get before she moves away in February.

Pray for God's Word to take solid root in Net's heart. Pray for clear communication for Ivy and one of our students who is helping to mentor Net.



Ivy and our pastor's wife have continued to work on getting a family-oriented drug-prevention program translated and started in our city.

Pray for good collaboration among the pastors and individuals interested in using the program. Pray for favor as our grant proposal is currently under review.



We're grateful for chances to partner with our local church as they reach out to neighborhood kids. Last month we had a game night. The rules for the games seemed to morph as the evening continued, but despite the chaos, the kids seemed to have fun. :)

We're working with a couple of church members to plan a Christmas outreach on Dec 23. Pray these children (and their parents!) would understand more of God's love and our need for a Savior.



Our current visa expires in January. This year there's a new process requiring a couple of forms that we don't have yet. (We don't THINK it will cause problems, but essentially our USA marriage certificate and birth certificate are no longer enough to "prove" that Ivy and Karis are related to Nate.) Pray for favor with the immigration officer when we attempt to renew our visa Dec 14. NOTE: Dec 13th they got their visas. (Picture: Celebrating our first day of having a teenager in the house. We hope for many more birthdays here in Thailand.) Whatever joys and challenges this season brings for you, may you experience Christ's peace and find joy in His fellowship.
